

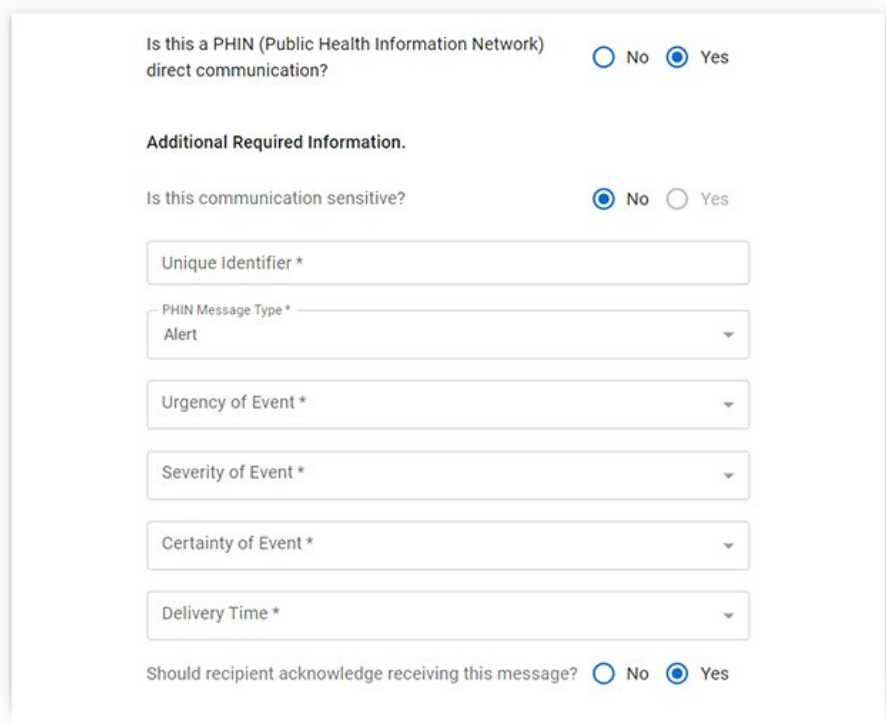
CORES HAN 5.7 Release Notes

PHIN Messaging

Public Health Information Network (PHIN) Messaging, developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), is again available in CORES HAN. You can use PHIN Messaging to securely send health-related messages to organizations with public health information systems. In addition to the Inbox, PHIN Messaging offers email and fax options and allows you to generate reports in PDF format.

Note: The ability to send sensitive PHIN messages through CORES HAN is coming soon.

Filter on Notification Templates

Now, notification templates can be filtered by access, making it easier to locate templates that are private, shared with anyone, or shared with organizations so you can get notifications out faster.
