

DesignStudio 1.2 Release Notes

These notes describe enhancements introduced in the DesignStudio 1.2 release scheduled for Tuesday, July 6, 2021. More information is available through the help in your solution or by contacting Juvare Support at 877-771-0911 or support@juvare.com.

Delete View Creation

A Delete View can now be created from the Quick Actions menu of an Input View. This new view leverages Juvare's new design for views and streamlines the implementation of a user's ability to "delete" records from a board. The message of the Delete View can be custom tailored to your needs and can be assigned to a List View. Once assigned to a List View the link for the Delete View is wrapped in a board permission and a view filter is added and applied to the view so users cannot see deleted records.

Styling of WebEOC Lists

Fields that are associated with WebEOC Lists now have unique styling that complements the standard board set. The styling is turned on by default but can be turned off through the Style tab, which is visible when creating a List View or editing a List View table. To take full advantage of this new feature, we recommend that your WebEOC lists have colors assigned to each list item in order to offset the white text color.

Styling of Standard Templates

The standard templates used for Input Views and Detail Views have been updated to better align with the design theme. For example, on Input Views, the Save and Cancel buttons are now located at the bottom of the view. On Details Views, the Return button is on the top left and the Edit button is on the top right and it is wrapped in a board permission. On List Views, the color of the Create New + button has been updated to white to match its appearance in WebEOC. To take advantage of these updates, existing Input Views, Detail Views, and List Views must be recreated.

Asterisk on Required Fields

On an Input View, fields that are marked as required will now have an asterisk next to the label to better indicate the requirement for users.

Resolutions

- When the Publish Profile does not contain publishing steps, the Publish button is deactivated in the board Designer.
- When creating a List View for a board, the options in one list are now cleared after navigating to another list.

- To improve legibility, the label for check boxes now appears darker.
- After creating a Details View and switching to another view when no changes were made, you are no longer prompted to save.
- When importing a board and trying to create a new view or resource, a warning message is no longer displayed.
- When editing a record in a WebEOC board, the date and time value now returns correctly.
