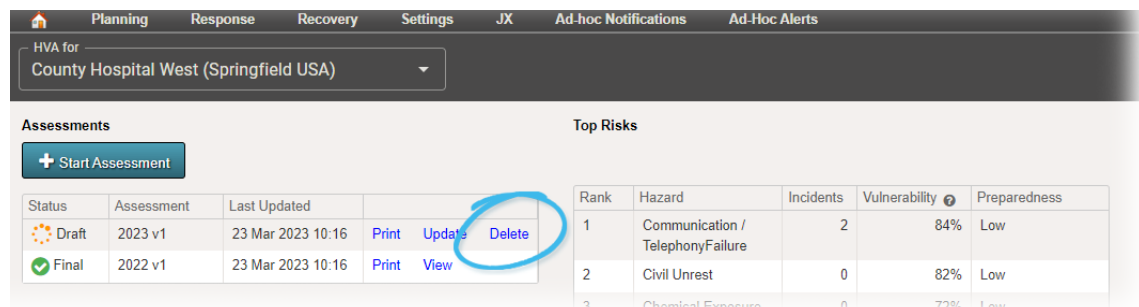


eICS™ 4.54 Release Notes

Hazard Vulnerability Analysis (HVA) Update

On the *Planning* tab, you can now delete draft assessments using the **Delete** option on the left of the row. This option helps administrators better maintain the HVA assessment list.

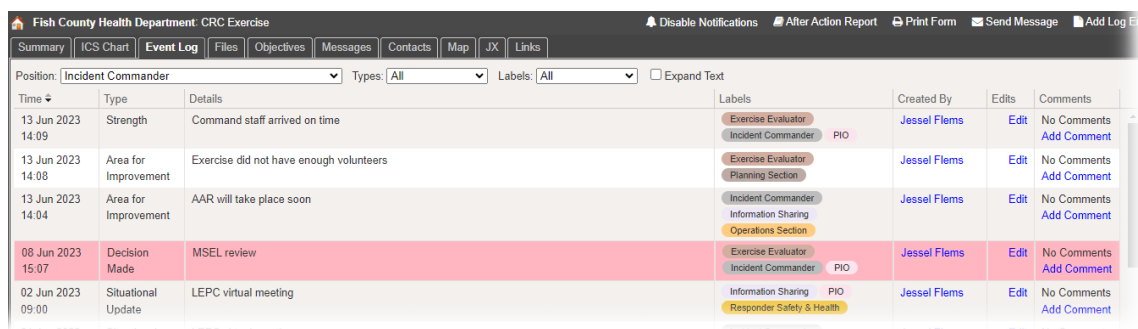
Logo Upload to Forms and Reports

Now, Domain and Facility Administrators can personalize reports by adding their logos. After uploading, the logo is displayed on all generated forms and reports. Logo images are accepted in JPEG or PNG format.

Event Log Entry Labels

To streamline the creation of incident documentation, you can now use labels to categorize and identify event log entries based on specific criteria, making it easier to search for relevant information and extract meaningful details from the event log. On the Event Log, you can:

- Select and display labels when creating a new incident log entry,
- View and filter event log entries by label and,
- Allow sharing of log entry comments with facility group and/or coalition partners.

Situational Report

When printing the HICS 2014 plan, a Situational Report is now available too. This report lists the log entries created during a specified time frame. It can be completed and generated at any time during the incident.

After Action Report and Improvement Plan Updates

To streamline the completion of the After Action Report and Improvement Plan, event log entry types related to strengths and improvements are now automatically included in the report. After associating an objective and capability, Facility Administrators can select the strength and improvement rating.

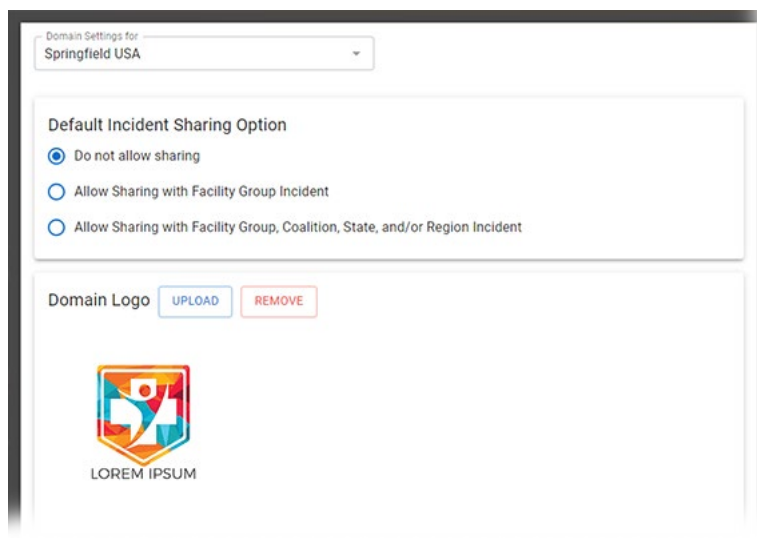
Upload Large Documents to Planning Tab

On the *Planning* tab, you can now upload larger documents to the Plan Summary and Library sections.

Settings Tab Enhancements

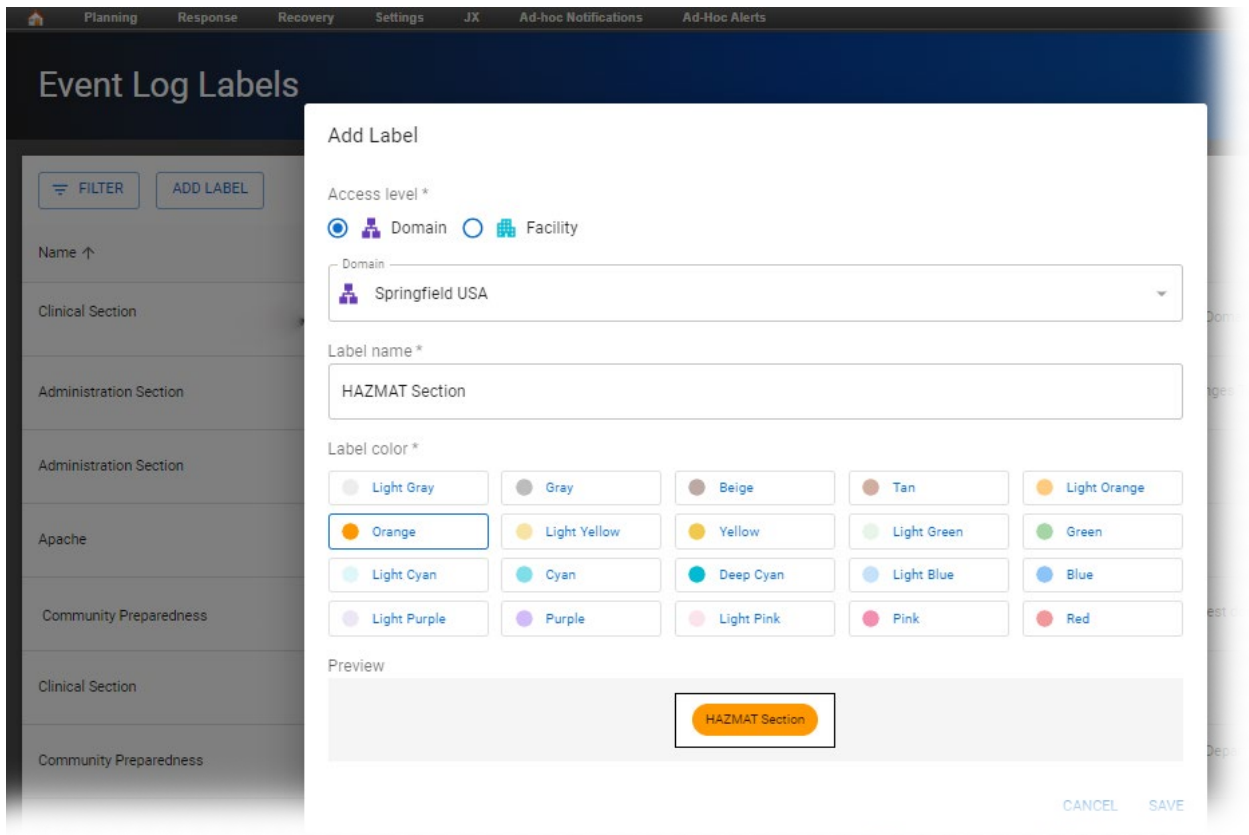
With this release, several enhancements were added to the *Settings* tab to allow administrators convenient access to manage default incident sharing, domain hazards, and event log labels for their domains and/or facilities. These enhancements include:

- On the *Domain Admin Settings* page, as a Domain Administrator, you can now select a default sharing option for incidents. This feature offers enhanced control and flexibility when managing information sharing within your domain. Additionally, you can upload a custom logo to display on forms and reports.



- On the *Domain Hazards* page, as a Domain Administrator, you can now add hazards not included on the HVA list. This lets you associate hazards and incidents specific to your domains and facilities.

- On the *Event Log Labels* page, as a Domain or Facility Administrator, you can now create event log labels to identify and categorize specific areas of interest for your domain and/or facility. The labels are named and assigned a color of your choosing, which is especially helpful when creating and reviewing incident documentation.
